### **Expectations for Transitioning from Apple iPads to Laptops**

Dear Families,

As your child moves from using an Apple iPad to using a laptop at school, they will make a significant learning with technology switch at AIS. We continue with our BYOD (Bring Your Own Device) Program, and we move from the guided learning supported by apps on their Apple iPad to using a laptop computer. All students will make the transition from Apple iPads to laptops to facilitate the greater need for typed written work when researching, creating, and documenting. This requires both modern technology and new skills. Below you will find the recent technology guidelines as well as advice on how to support them in practicing some of the skills they will need. From this point forward in your child's education a laptop is the device expectations at AIS that will best suit learning with technology.

Internet Access		

Internet access is important as it will allow your child to share work with their teacher, classmates, families, do research, and more.

To connect to the school network, please take the device to the IT office (located just inside the main entrance). Our filtering software enables safety of access to approved content only when students are connected to school wi-fi. In the past connection fees have been 25KD per year and will be fully set up by our IT staff. Parents will be notified of the Internet Access Setup by the IT Department before the beginning of the school year.

Personal cell phone hotspots will not be permitted at any time.

Software, Email address and Passwords

Your child will continue to access **Microsoft Office 365** with their current account. The username and password will remain the same. Links to both Office 365 and the school email can be found on the students' page on our website: <u>https://www.ais-kuwait.org/students/</u>.

# All Office 365 applications (Teams, Word, Excel, PowerPoint) should be downloaded to your child's computer before the school year begins.
